

Empowering Clinicians to Become Clinician Stewards

Through an IllumiCare pilot program sponsored by the Texas Hospital Association, a number of health systems in Texas are empowering their providers by giving them a real-time view of the human and economic cost of their care.

Results across many different hospitals indicate that this transparency does empower the stewardship of clinicians.

Financial Burden on Patients

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3 in 10 Americans report problems paying medical bills.





73% Among them cut back on food and other basic needs to pay for their medical bills.

Higher utilization and more spending does not equate to better outcomes.



United States spends almost 80% more than Germany and 2x more than Canada, France and Japan

But Life expectancy is almost **2 years** below the OECD average.

The Untapped Potential of the Clinician Steward


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80% of physicians

were unable to accurately estimate the cost of medical tests

None of the physicians estimated with greater than 50% accuracy.





Cost and Risk Transparency

Spending on hospital care services represents 32% of total health care spending in 2016, US healthcare's largest spending portion. A figure that is unchanged since 2013.

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Success Factors

Follow the three step transformation from clinician to clinician steward 2. Unobtrusively educate providers about stewardship opportunities

Get providers into an efficiency mindset

Measuring Use and Impact

\$170.16 per admission decrease is the cost of inpatient med, lab and rad tests.

5.6% reduction of inpatient radiology costs per hospital.

14.3% reduction in inpatient lab costs

14.2% average reduction of inpatient medication costs

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- Collectively, these hospitals represent 143,338 annual inpatient admissions.
- No negative effects on mortality, readmissions or length of stay have been observed
